Centile	Decile	Marks
Top 10% (i.e. 90 – 100%)	10 th	20 marks
Next 20% (i.e. 70 – 89%)	8 th / 9 th	16 marks
Next 40% (i.e. 30 – 69%)	4 th / 5 th / 6 th / 7 th	12 marks
Next 20% (i.e. 10 – 29%)	2 nd / 3 rd	6 marks
Lowest 10% (i.e. 0 – 9%)	1 st	4 marks

Maximum 20 marks available.

Centile/Decile should be provided as an official document from the university – either on university letterhead or in an email from the university clearly showing university return address and contact.

If the candidate does not supply a centile/decile ranking, they will be awarded the lowest score of **4 marks**.

If the candidate provides a letter stating their university does not provide centile/decile rankings, **6 marks is to be awarded**.
